Liturgical and Pastoral Care Outreach Ministry Opportunities

- Lector: proclaim (reads) the scripture readings, at mass, prayers of the faithful and welcome announcements. (*training session required*)
- Eucharistic Minister: distribute Holy Communion at Mass (*training session required*).
- Gift bearers: take up the collection at mass and bring gifts forward
- Server: assist Father at Mass (*must have received their First Holy Communion (training sessions required)*)
- Greeter: welcome parishioners and visitors; hand out bulletins before Mass. (*children and youth are welcome to this ministry*)
- Sacristan: prepare (sets-up) the worship space for mass (bread, wine, candles lighted, ministers available).
- Art & Environment/Liturgy Committee: prepare the worship space for seasonal décor and celebrations. Sewing, making banners, floral arranging and crafts
- Hospitality-Set-up for coffee & treats before Mass— Clean-up after the 9:00 AM Mass
- Treats and Sweets: Provide treats for Sunday morning refreshments
- Collection Counter

Music Ministry

- Sing-Cantor or play and instrument with the Adult/Youth choir at Mass.
- *Rehearsal every Thursday evening at 7:00 PM*
- Sing with the Children's choir at Mass
- *Rehearsal every Wednesday evening at 7:00 PM*

Pastoral Care Outreach Ministry

- Card Ministry— prepare and mail Get Well, Sympathy, and Anniversary Cards
- Visit the Homebound
- Visit the Sick or Hospitalized

- Visit those in the assisted living units and nursing homes
- Take Eucharist to the homebound, nursing homes, and /or assisted living units
- Prepare and or Deliver a meal to those recuperating from illness
- Greenhouse Ministry: *Help with growing flowers for the home bound and parish grounds.*
- College Connections: *Help prepare parish care packages for college students from our parish.*
- Oct-ember Fest Fall Gathering for Food Bank
- Christmas Community Outreach Ministry
- “We Deliver” Homeless Lunch Program. Prepare sack lunches for delivery/call parishioners to donate supply items.
